PARKING: Plenty of parking on site near Birdwing Park – follow the signs and Parking Marshalls' directions.

Begin your trick or treating at the Registration Marquee in Birdwing Park to pick up a map of all participating houses on the Trick or Treat Trail.

Unwrapped treats are a health and safety risk and must not be handed out. 5. One (1) prize, as advertised, will be awarded to the Best Decorated House on the Trick or Treat Trail. This prize will be selected by Bluewattle's appointed judging panel. The judges' decision is final and no negotiation will be entered into. The prize is not transferrable and may not be redeemed for cash. 6. All Halloween decorations must be removed from participating homes no later than 5 November 2018. 7.
